Ok well the first thing you have to do is determine if injection is working or not

open a terminal and type

#### Code:

sudo iwconfig

this will tell you the interface your using, mines is called 'wlan0' but depending on the drivers you use you might get wif0 or ath0, whatever your interface is called is what you should use for all commands

Then you need to put your interface in monitor mode, my monitor interface is called mon0 but yours might be different

#### Code:

sudo airmon-ng start wlan0

run sudo iwconfig again and check that monitor mode is enabled

then run the injection test

#### Code:

sudo aireplay-ng -9 wlan0

if injection is working you get a message like this

- **16:29:41 wlan0 channel: 9**: This tells you which interface was used and the channel it was running on.
- 16:29:41 Injection is working!: This confirms your card can inject.
- **16:29:42 Found 5 APs**: These access points (APs) were found either through the broadcast probes or received beacons.
- **16:29:42 00:09:5B:5C:CD:2A channel: 11 'NETGEAR'**: Notice that this AP is on channel 11 and not on our card channel of 9. It is common for adjacent channels to spill over.
- **16:29:55 Ping (min/avg/max): 2.763ms/4.190ms/8.159ms**: It an AP responds with one or more packets then the ping times are calculated.
- **16:29:55 27/30: 90%** for teddy: This is the only AP that the card can successfully communicate with. This is another verification that your card can inject. You will also notice that all the other APs have 0%.

If injection testing doesnt work using the interface wlan0(or whatever yours is called) then try running it on mon0(or whatever your monitor interface is called)

if you get a different message post the output and then we can work out if its the driver needs patching or not

I'm running 11:04 natty narwahl too but aircrack and kismet use a modified kernel and will most likely muck up your 11:04 install, i'm having trouble with mine at the mo, when i try and use aircrack or kismet my pc just crashes. i would recommend installing backtrack 5 alongside 11:04 and using that to run aircrack and kismet, it's what backtrack was designed for and i have no problems running aircrack and kismet from backtrack, just a bit of a chore rebooting the pc everytime.
